

#### Public Works Refuse Rate Proposal – OnE Team

- Outreach and Enforcement (OnE) Team
  - Staff Levels (10.0) FTE
    - One staff per zone, with one Supervisor
    - Three staff for swing, night shift
    - Alignment with Zone Supervisor for improved collaboration and coordination
  - Public Works Role and Coordination
    - Code Enforcement and Compliance
    - Educate residents of waste disposal, ensure proper use of refuse services
    - Guided by 311 service request
    - Engagement with neighborhood and community groups
    - Proactive outreach on key commercial areas during scheduled evening and early-morning inspections
    - Weekly CleanCorridorsSF operations in neighborhood commercial corridors






### Public Works Refuse Rate Proposal – OnE Team

- COVID-19 pandemic impact shown
- Measurement of No Garbage Service Notice of Violations (NOV)
- Coordinate with Recology on garbage services
- Cleaning staff have identified issues and tracked illegal dumping in areas

311 Service Orders Received for Enforcement-Related Issues





#### Public Works Refuse Rate Proposal—Abandoned Materials

- Partnership with Recology
- Service Level Agreements (SLAs)
  - 4 hours for most abandoned materials
  - Electronics, mattresses, furniture, appliances, and contained garbage
- Key Recology Service
  - Recology trucks size efficiency
  - After hour service by Public Works
- Additional Changes
  - Expanded coverage by Recology
  - Continue focus on hotspot areas





#### Public Works Refuse Rate Proposal – City Can Service

- Partnership with Recology
- Service Level Agreements (SLAs)
  - 2 hour for overflowing garbage can
  - o 72 hours for litter receptacle maintenance
- Key Recology Service
  - Allows Public Works to focus on other refuse
- Additional Changes
  - Review of trashcan sensor data
  - Potential reallocation and adjustments with analysis of trash can sensor data
    - Create efficiencies
    - Adjust pickup frequency
