## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A GRANT IS#JUV2023-01 SECURE COMMITMENT TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

The San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department (JPD) issued IS#JUV2023-01 (Sourcing Event ID 0000008600) on 08/14/2023. The intent was to select a transitional housing and supportive services provider for young people leaving secure commitment at Juvenile Hall.

JPD received one responsive Proposal and was considered in the evaluation process. The Proposer's final score met the minimum point threshold of 70 points, which determined them to be eligible for award consideration.

JPD intends to award a 2-year grant with a not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 to **Mary's Help, Inc.**, pending approval from the Juvenile Probation Commission, and will promptly commence contract negotiations after approval.

As stated in Section J.3 ("Protest of Grant Award") of the solicitation's Appendix B ("Solicitation Additional Terms and Conditions"), a Proposer may submit a written Notice of Protest of Grant Award within three (3) business days of this notice's issue date. The Notice of Protest must include a written statement specifying in detail each and every one of the grounds asserted for the protest. The Notice of Protest must be signed by an individual authorized to represent the Proposer, and must cite the law, rule, local ordinance, procedure or Solicitation provision on which the protest is based. In addition, the Notice of Protest must specify facts and evidence sufficient for the City to determine the validity of the protest.

The issued date of this notice is September 6, 2023.
