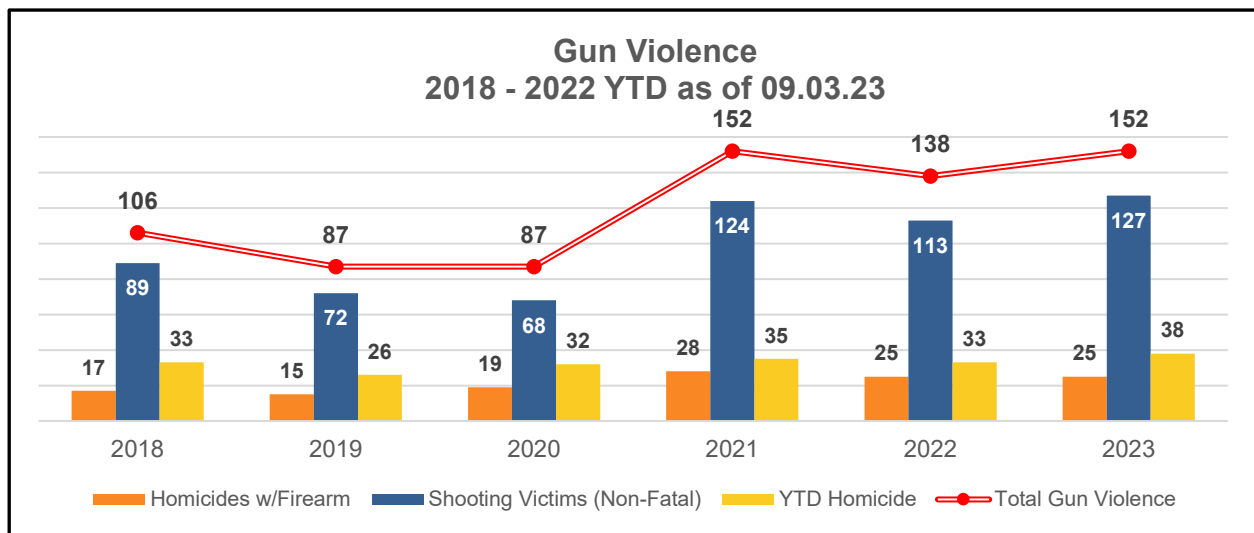

GUN VIOLENCE – UP 10% compared to 2022

- **There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 130 incidents resulting in 152 victims
- **There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 09.03.23**
 - There are 38 homicides YTD with 25 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 78%**

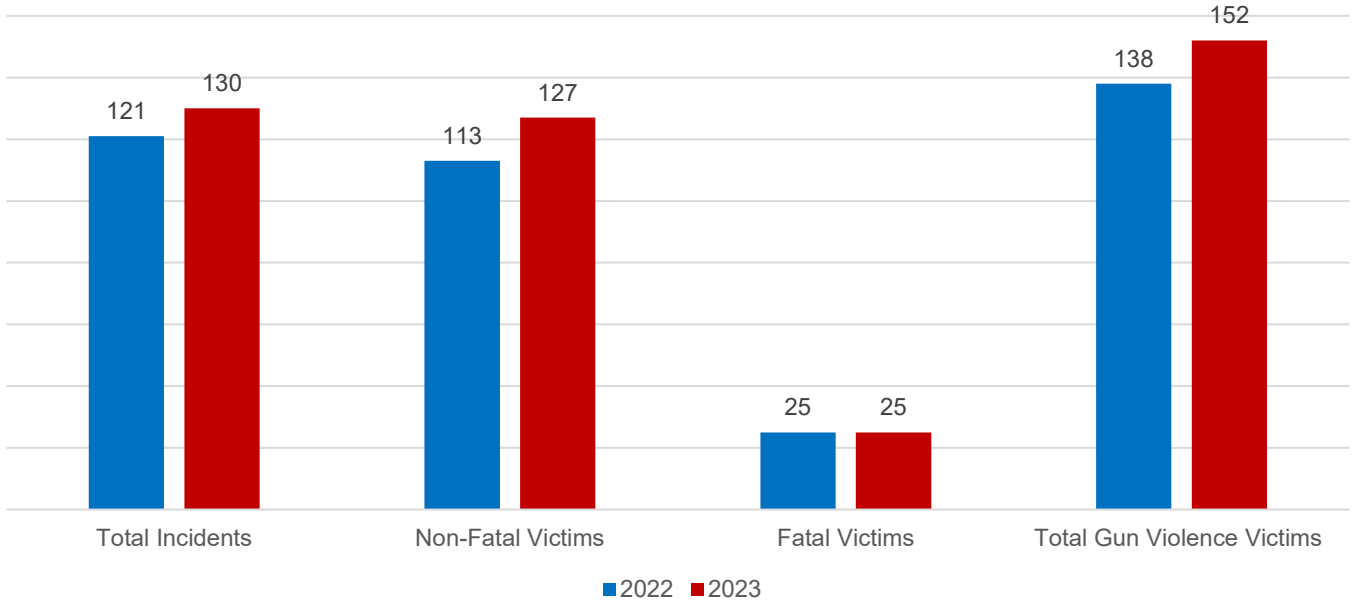

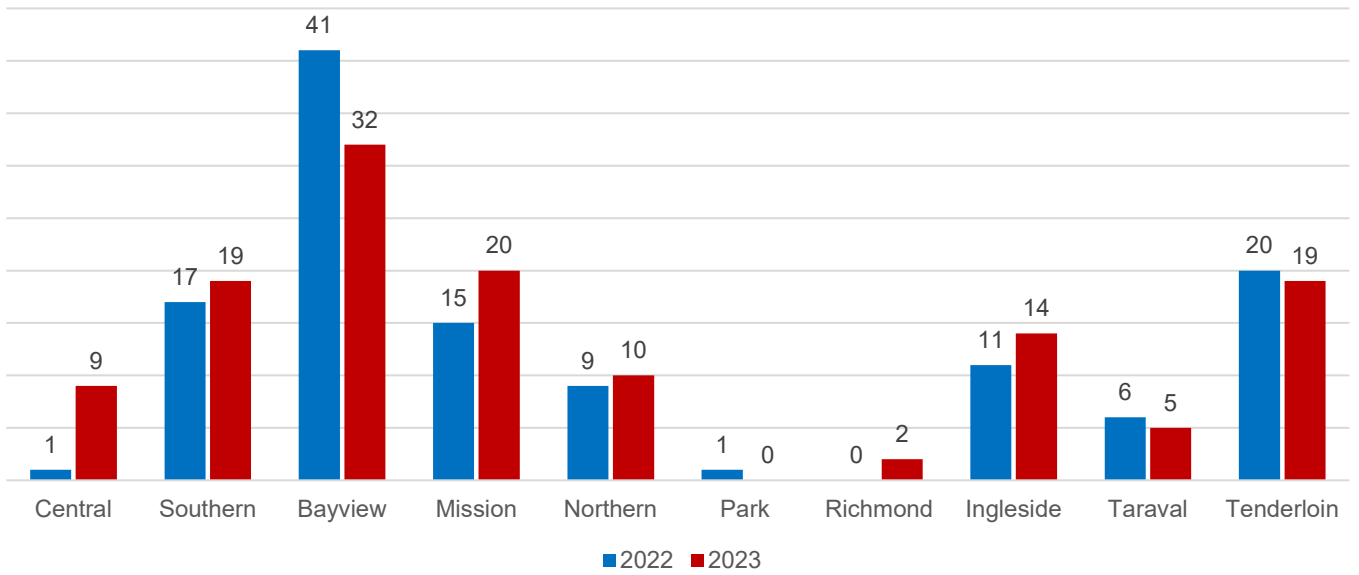

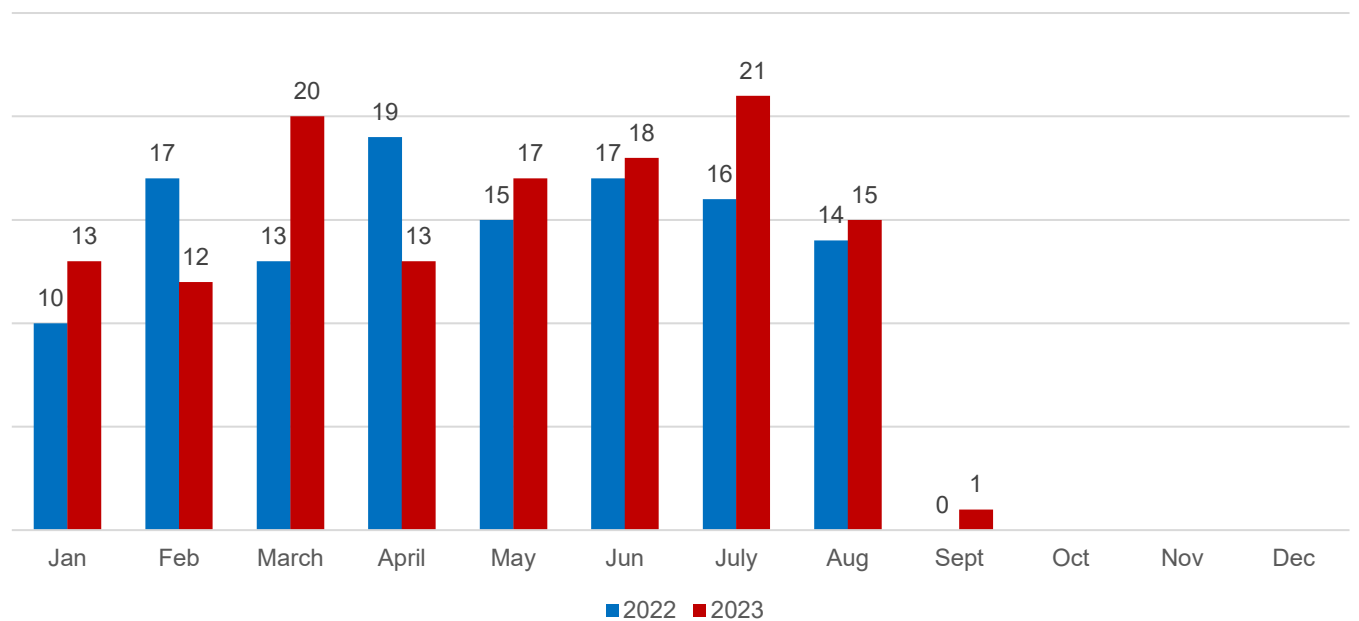
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



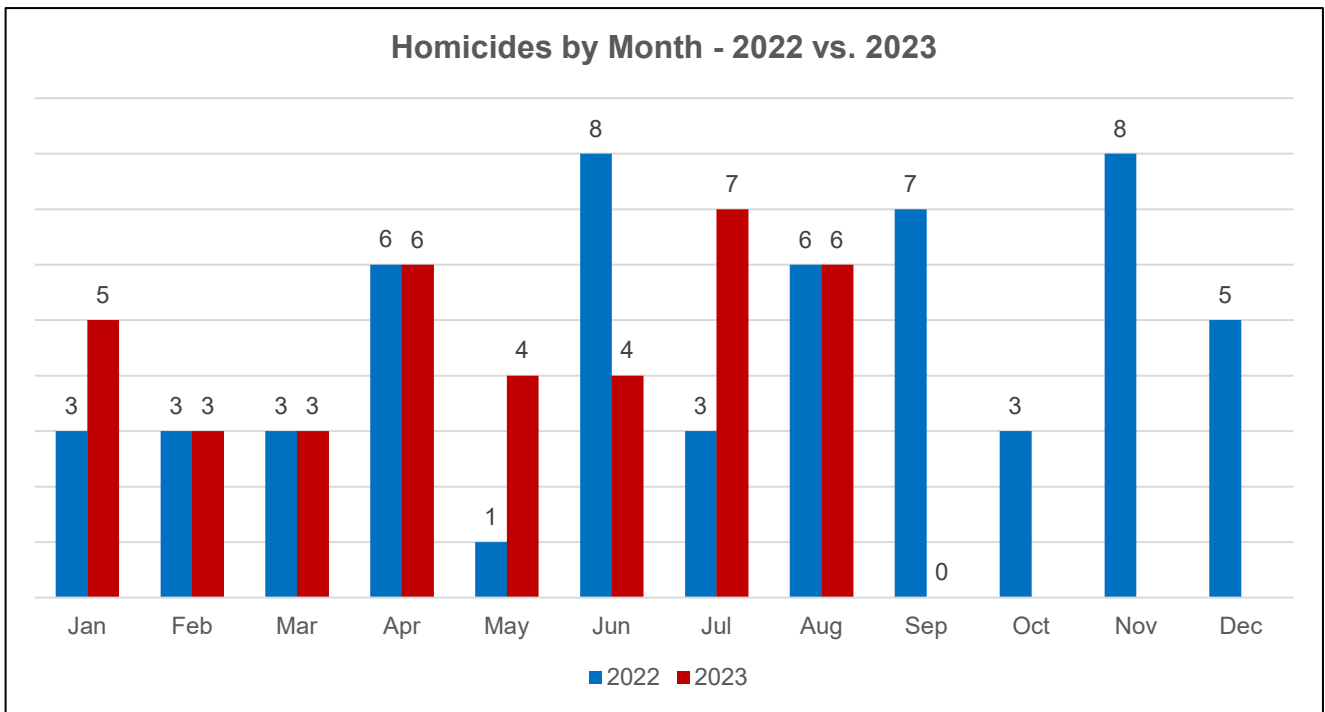
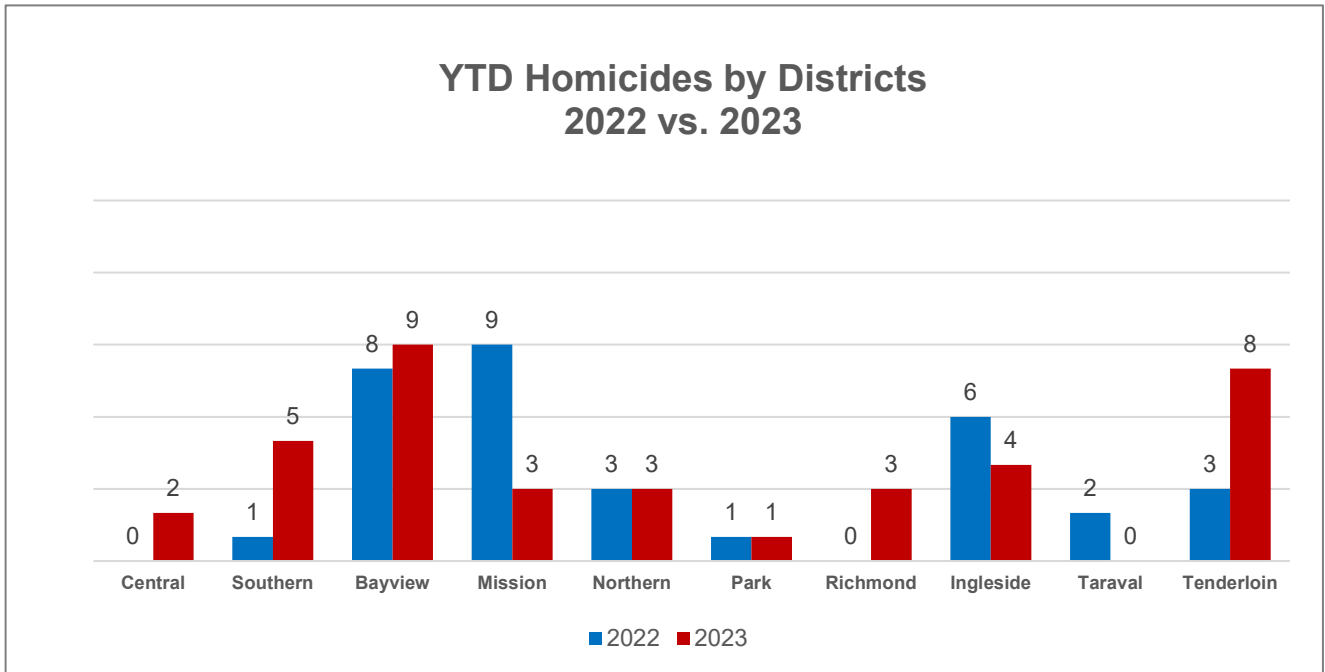
Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
