Disaster and Emergency Response and Recovery Fund (DERR) The San Francisco Disaster and Emergency Response and Recovery Fund is a response and recovery measure to ensure San Francisco's ability to quickly respond to and recover from disaster and emergency events. Laguna Honda Gift Fund (LHH) The Laguna Honda Gift Fund enhances quality of life and independence of Laguna Honda residents. The Fund allows for the special touches in support of the individual needs of residents at Laguna Honda Hospital. Animal Care and Control Fund (ACC) This fund serves San Francisco's stray, injured, abandoned and abused animals. ACC is the only organization in San Francisco that accepts and tries to place all animals, domestic and wild. ACC responds to all animal related emergencies to protect and assist humans and animals. Kindergarten to College Fund (K2C) Kindergarten to College (K2C) starts a college savings account with \$50 for every incoming kindergartener in the San Francisco Unified School District, and provides savings incentives and other support to help children attend college. **Neighborhood Beautification Fund (NBF)** The NBF, also known as the Community Challenge Grant Program (CCG), provides matching grants for projects like graffiti clean-up and small physical improvements to neighborhoods. CCG also funds community-based projects to manage storm water. Recreation and Parks Gift Fund (RPG) The Recreation and Parks Department maintains and operates neighborhood parks, playgrounds, recreation centers, and other facilities that add to the quality of life of all San Franciscans and those who visit and work here. **Voluntary Arts Contribution Fund (VAC)** Since its inception in 1984, the VACF has provided about \$1.1 million in vital support to hundreds of the city's most beloved arts organizations.
