Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to express my severe disappointment with the recent actions of the Police Commission, especially those of Vice President Carter-Oberstone, concerning the proposed ballot measure to undo the burdensome regulations imposed by this commission. I would remind commissioners that they are not a legislative body and the idea that they would oppose, or even discuss, the democratic implementation of common-sense standards is repugnant. It seems that the limited policy-making power that commission is granted has gone to your heads so that you think you can regulate even the democratic process in San Francisco.
