Key Facts

- The City and County of San Francisco government will remain fully operational.
- Businesses, offices, and services can stay open!
- Employees and patrons may need to build in extra time to get around, especially between November 15-18.
- The areas within the secured perimeter will still be accessible to businesses, customers, and residents.
- Accessing these areas will require going through a bag check. There will not be any ID checks, including proof of residence, citizenship, or employment.
- Commuters should plan for transit reroutes and traffic congestion.
- Some City services, like street cleaning or trash pick up, may operate on a different schedule.
- Some streets will be closed to traffic briefly for motorcades and special events.
- Transit lines and schedules will change. BART and Caltrain schedules will be the same.
- Some MUNI lines will be rerouted. Ferries will be impacted.



APEC Leaders' Week is taking place at the Moscone Center. Throughout the week, there will also be security zones around Nob Hill, the waterfront, and Legion of Honor. Nearby residents, business owners, and workers should plan for the additional security. Details are at sf.gov/apec

The Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) is a regional forum established to leverage the growing interdependence of the Asia-Pacific region. San Francisco is proud to be the Host City for APEC Leaders' Week, a gathering of 20,000 visitors (from the government, press, private sector, and public) from 21 APEC economies, including official APEC delegates.

Everyone in and around the secure areas should expect increased security throughout the week of November 11-17. Additional security measures will be in place during one portion of APEC week from November 15-18, due to the National Special Security Event (NSSE) designation by the U.S. Secret Service.

During APEC, San Francisco residents, business-owners, and workers will experience impacts to transit, traffic, and access to some parts of the City.
