NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A GRANT
RFP#JUV2023-01 MULTISYSTEMIC THERAPY SERVICES

The San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department (JPD) issued RFP#JUV2023-01 (Sourcing Event ID 0000008672) on 09/08/2023. JPD's intent was to select a qualifying 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Mental Health Service Organization to support the development and implementation of a Multisystemic Therapy Services team.

JPD received two (2) Proposals responsive, and both were considered in the evaluation process. JPD has issued the award to the Proposer whose Proposal received the highest-ranking score.

The **Seneca Family of Agencies** proposal has been selected for a grant award, pending approval from the Juvenile Probation Commission.

The grant will have an initial 2-year term with a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,638,000, including \$1,494,500 for the MST team and service delivery, and \$143,500 for MST training, quality assurance, and licensure. At least 80% of team and service costs are expected to be reimbursed by Medi-Cal. Note that the final award amount and term are still contingent on funding availability and will be finalized during negotiations.

As stated in Section J.3 ("Protest of Grant Award") of the solicitation's Appendix B ("RFP Additional Terms and Conditions"), a Proposer may submit a written Notice of Protest of Grant Award within three (3) business days of this notice's issue date. The Notice of Protest must include a written statement specifying in detail each and every one of the grounds asserted for the protest. The Notice of Protest must be signed by an individual authorized to represent the Proposer, and must cite the law, rule, local ordinance, procedure, or Solicitation provision on which the protest is based. In addition, the Notice of Protest must specify facts and evidence sufficient for the City to determine the validity of the protest.

The issued date of this notice is October 27, 2023.
