**The Way It Is Now:** The San Francisco Unified School District (School District) is a public agency that is separate from the City and operates the San Francisco public school system. The School District previously offered Algebra 1 courses to students in eighth grade. Currently, the School District offers Algebra 1 courses to students starting in ninth grade

**The Proposal:** Proposition \_ would make it City policy to encourage the School District to offer Algebra 1 to students by their eighth grade year and to support the School District's development of its math curriculum for students at all grade levels.

**A "YES" Vote Means:** If you vote "yes," you want to make it City policy to encourage the School District to offer Algebra 1 to students by their eighth grade year and to support the School District's development of its math curriculum.
