Implementation Update

- FY 22/23
 - 1 Petition filed in FY 22/23
 - 1 individual process was started but converted to an LPS conservatorship
- 3 Individuals conserved through SB1045
 - All 3 SB1045 conservatorships have been converted to LPS conservatorship
- Individuals that have been monitored/noticed for SB1045, and not conserved, have been assessed and referred to the appropriate level of care (AOT / Care Court / SB43)
