

Sign Requirements for Public Pool Facilities

- The following requirements can be found in the July 1, 2015 Supplement to Title 24, part 2, volume 2 of the 2013 CA Building Code.
- Requirements apply to all new and existing public pool facilities effective July 1, 2015. **Note:** Pool or public pool is defined as an artificial basin, chamber or tank constructed or prefabricated with impermeable surfaces that is used, or intended to be used, for public swimming, diving or recreational activities but does not include individual therapeutic tubs or baths where the main purpose is the cleaning of the body.

The following signs are required:

All signs shall have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high, *(unless otherwise required).* (3120B.1)

POOL CAPACITY A sign shall indicate the maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool. CPR An illustrated diagram with <u>text at</u> <u>least 1/4 inch</u> (6 mm) high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures. (3120B.5)	Sign shall be affixed to a wall, pole, gate, or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all pool users.	 Pools Spas Spray Grounds Wading Pools 	
911 The emergency telephone number 911 with numbers <u>not</u> <u>less than 4 inches</u> , the number of the nearest emergency services (Fire Department) and the name and street address of the pool facility with numbers and text not less than 1 inch shall be posted. DIARRHEA A sign in letters at least <u>1 inch</u> (25 mm) high and in a language or diagram which clearly states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water. (3120B.11)	Sign shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool. SIGN	LOCATION	REQUIRED FOR:	EXAMPLE
 SPA WARNING A warning sign for spa pools shall be posted stating, %GAUTION+and shall include the following language in letters at least 1 inch (25 mm) high. (3120B.7): 1. Elderly persons, pregnant women, infants and those with health conditions requiring medical care should consult with a physician before entering the spa. 2. Unsupervised use by children under the age of 14 is prohibited. 3. Hot water immersion while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, drugs, or medicines may lead to serious consequences and is not recommended. 4. Do not use alone. 5. Long exposure may result in hyperthermia, nausea, dizziness, or fainting. EMERGENCY SHUT OFF Sign in letters at least one inch (25mm) high and stating, GMERGENCY SHUT OFF SWITCH.+ (3120B.8)	Sign shall be posted at the spa emergency shut off.	• Spas	EMERGENCY SHUT-OFF SWITCH

Additional Sign May Be Required For:

KEYED GATES If pool enclosure has gates that require a key to exit, those gates and/or doors which will allow egress without a key shall have a sign in letters at least <u>4 inches</u> (102 mm) high stating EMERGENCY EXIT. (3119B.2 (3)) Note: -A pool enclosure shall have at least one means of egress without a key for emergency purposes.	Sign shall be posted on gates/doors where keyless egress is possible.	EXIT EXIT
NO LIGHTS If pool was constructed without lighting or if lighting is inoperable, a sign shall be posted stating, NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK .+(3120B.9)	Sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s).	No Use of Pool Allowed After Dark
