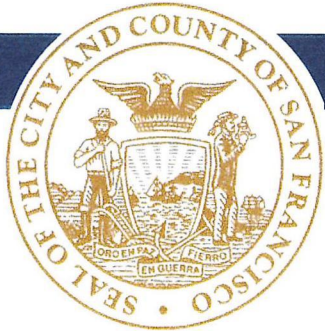

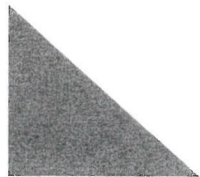
Department Bulletins/Notices

Status updates on 71 Department Notices set to expire within 120 days.



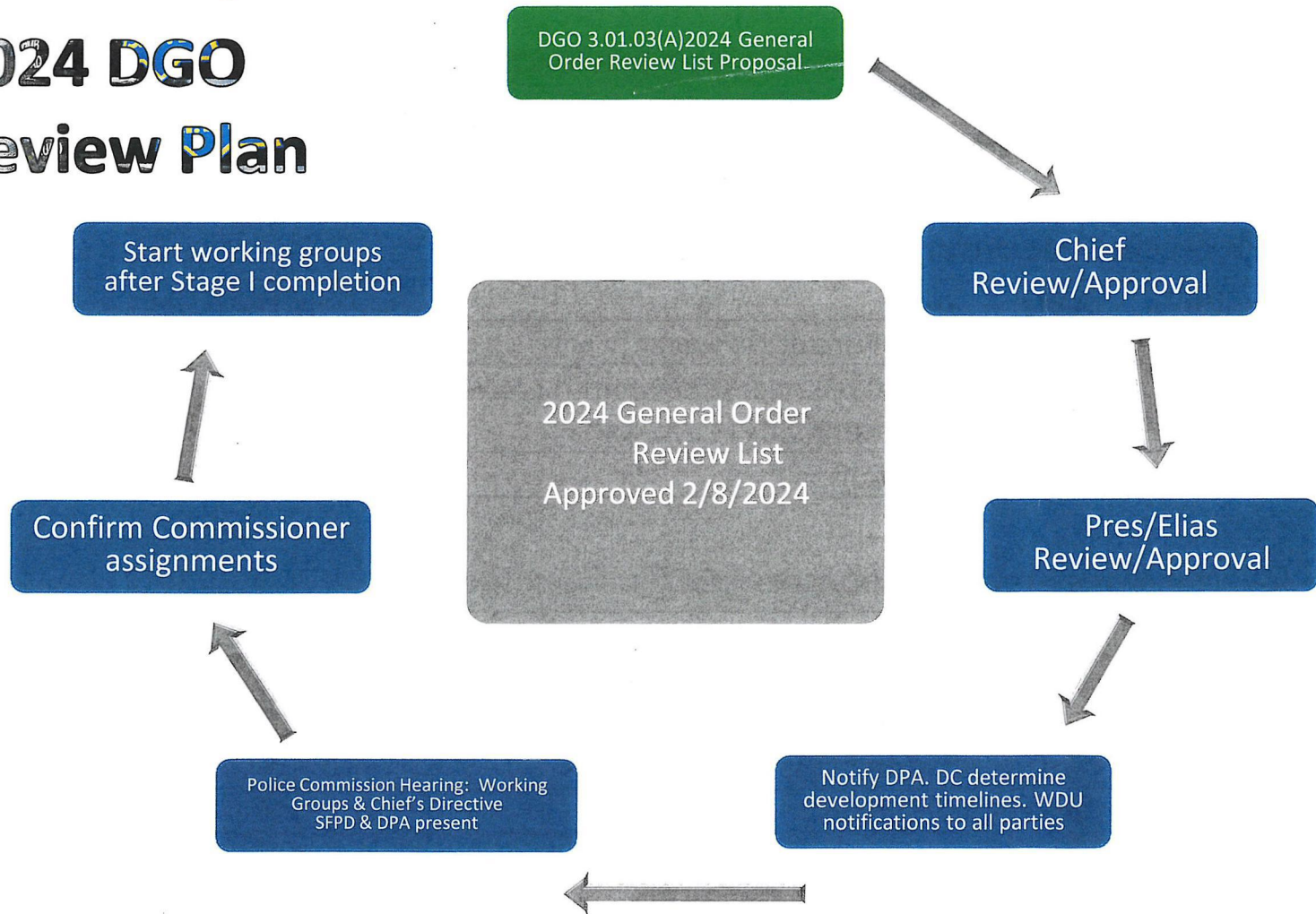
Draft DGO 7.01 Update

- Posted for 30-day Public Review Process (DGO 3.01.04(D)). Concluded on December 13, 2023
- Received 55 entries = 40 Comments/Recommendations
- ✓ 7 of which were incorporated into the draft DGO
- ✓ 14 were Q&A, not for inclusion in draft DGO
- ✓ 4 require further discussion (Simultaneous Concurrence)
- ✓ 15 recommendations will not be included in draft DGO
- Received additional recommendations outside of Public Review Process from JPD. Reviewing JPD edits to prepare for Simultaneous Concurrence discussion.
- Draft DGO 7.01 scheduled for Simultaneous Concurrence on 4/5/2024 . Meetings must conclude on or before 6/3/2024
- At close of Simultaneous Concurrence, SFPD and DPA will conclude joint preparation of response to Public Review before Police Commission submission
- Last step: Police Commission Office Submission

Q3 Sparks Report Follow-up

- DGO 6.10 Missing Persons added to 2024 General Order Review List as a priority DGO. Starting at Stage I of DGO development, per DGO 3.01 (DC considering 60-day Stage I timeline). Will inherit all recommendation grids as well as request new recommendation grids. Police Commission will determine whether DGO 6.10 should be assigned to a working group.
- DPA access to SFPD's Body Worn Camera Viewing Platform (Evidence.com). Requires further analysis to determine whether there are SF Administrative Code 96 or SF OCA contracting rule compliance issues if Department accepts DPA onto its Axon account. The DA's Office can receive SFPD BWC footage through the Evidence.com platform as they have their own Axon/Evidence.com account and act as a sharing partner for ease of data transfer. The sharing agreement is managed by Axon/Evidence.com. It is recommended that DPA seek its own contract agreement with Axon/Evidence.com so the platform can be managed by DPA staff and DPA can request to be a sharing partner with SFPD. SFPD provided DPA with the Axon account manager's information in October 2023.
