REQUITY engagement

40%

of drop-in events were directly provided on-site at public housing or shelters, ensuring accessibility for the communities served.

\$455K

552 people signed up for Requity classes through a scholarship with a subsidy of 50% or 100% discount, amounting to a combined subsidy of roughly \$455,000.

85%

of the scholarship recipients live in public housing or affordable housing, 12% in shelters, and 3% are in foster care.

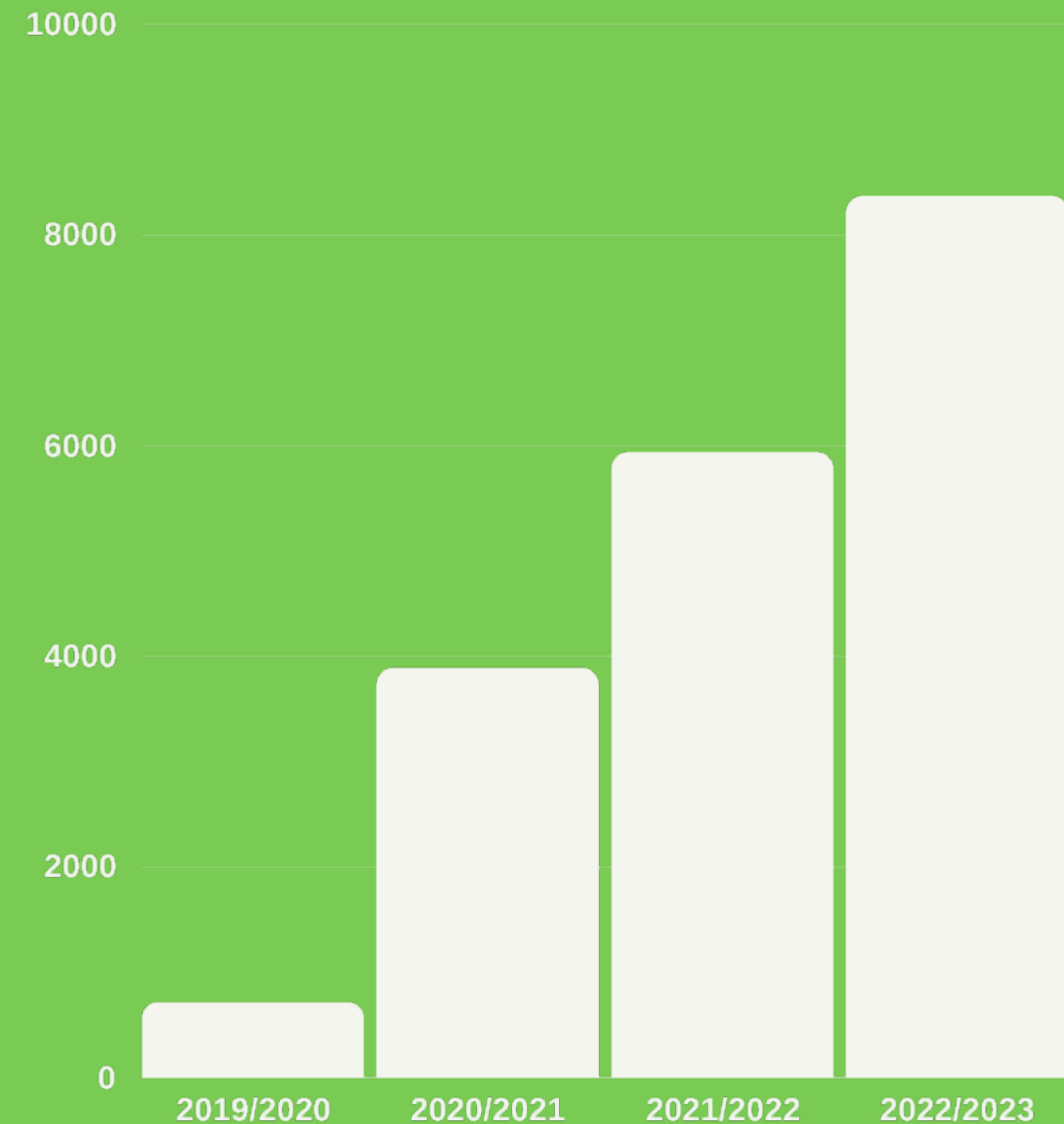
