

**2.05 ADULT POST-CARDIAC ARREST or
RETURN OF SPONTANEOUS CIRCULATION (ROSC)**

BLS Treatment
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• CPR/AED• After ROSC, monitor pulse closely, leave AED pads in place.• Resume CPR immediately if the patient loses pulse again• Oxygen as indicated.
ALS Treatment
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• IV/IO with Normal Saline TKO. Place second large bore IV with Normal Saline.• Normal Saline fluid bolus if SBP < 90 or signs of hypoperfusion, and lungs are clear. Repeat PRN.• If fluid bolus ineffective, may administer Dopamine Epinephrine Infusion Infuse at 1-3 drops/second IV/IO using a 10 drop/ml macrodrip chamber (or available alternate). Titrate to maintain SBP > 90.• Obtain and transmit 12 Lead ECG.
