

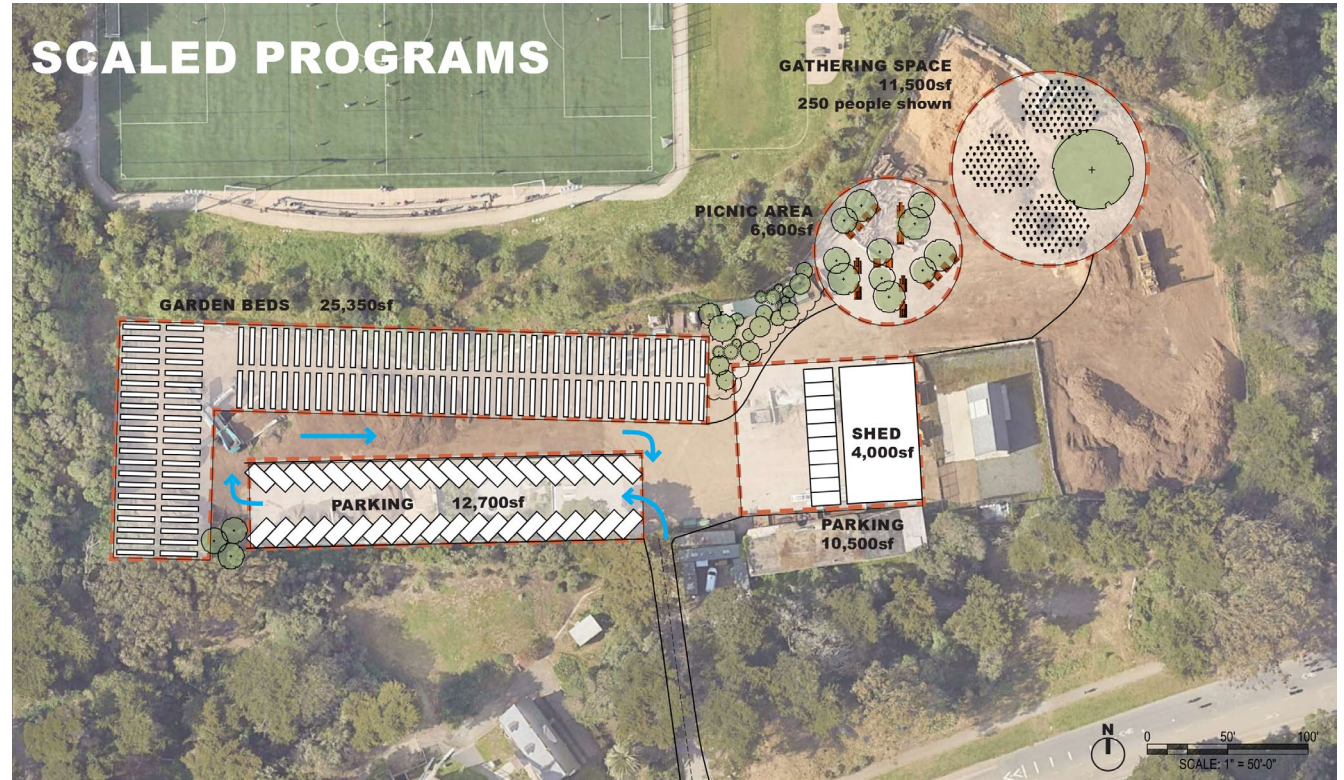

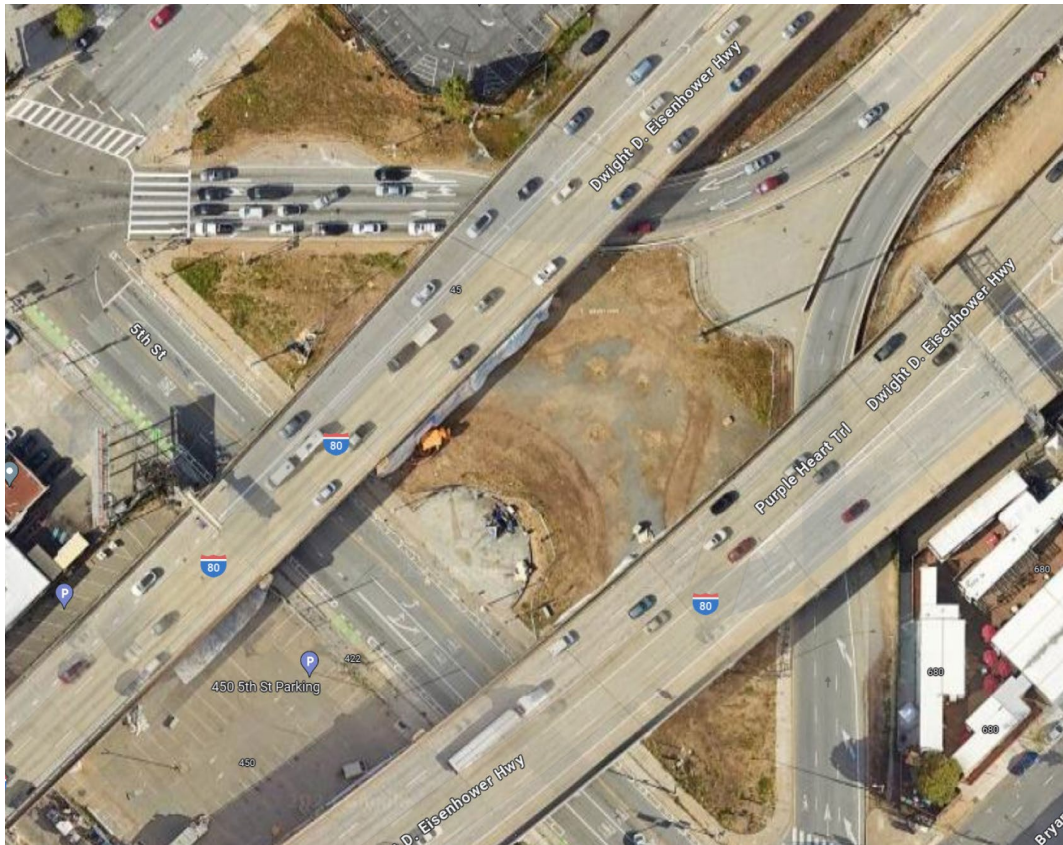
Benefits

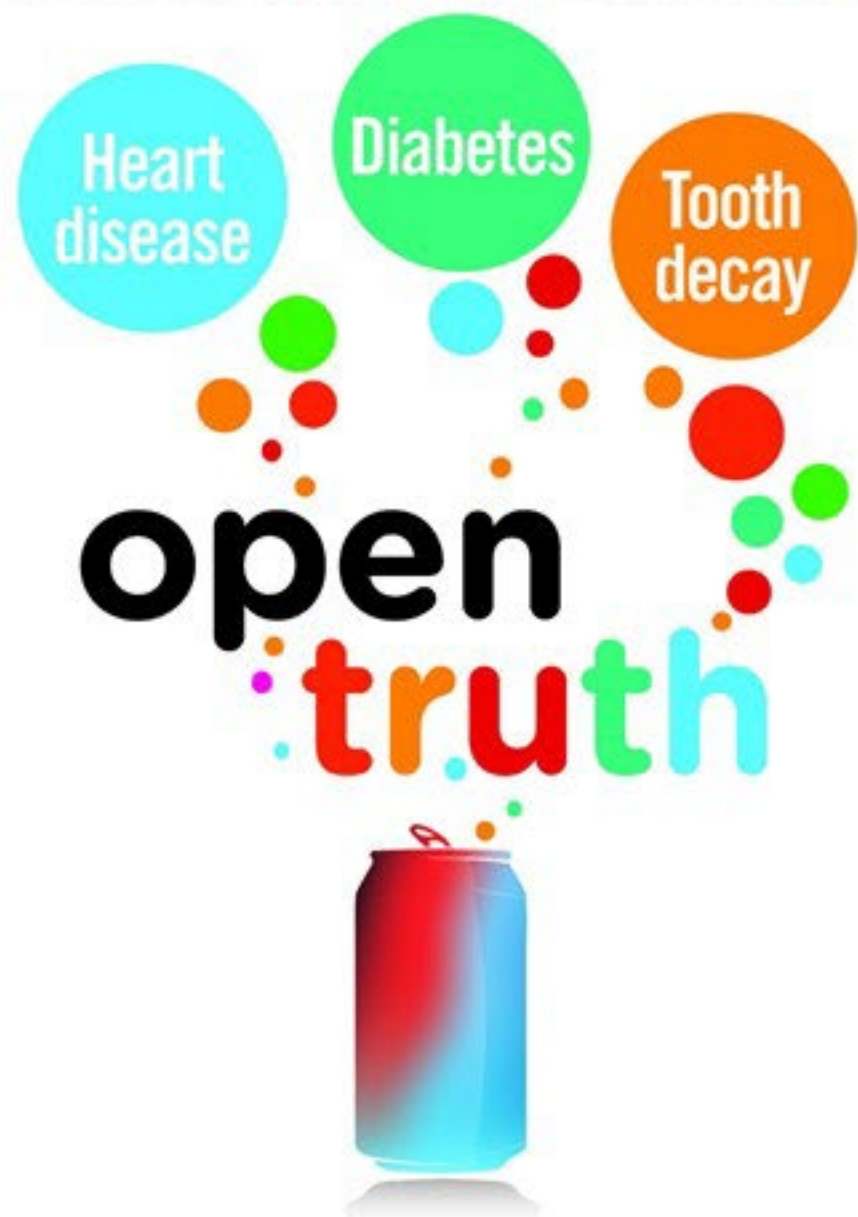
