Last week, at 2:00AM while we were sleeping, someone rammed the back of their vehicle into our garage in an attempt to break-in. Fortunately for us, they didn't get into our garage because we had installed bolts on our garage door in a response to people drilling holes in garages in order to open them and steel what is inside (shameful in it's own right). After spending \$5K to replace our garage door that had been smashed in, we now find ourselves in the position of having to address all of you regarding this incident. NO ONE SHOULD EVER HAVE THIS HAPPEN TO THEM!

It is high time the officials of this city to do something about the crime! It is unconscionable that anyone in San Francisco should have to endure what we have with our garage burglary, have their cars constantly broken into, their garages broken into, their front and back doors smashed in or be visiting San Francisco and have all your personal belongings stolen out of your rental car. How this city is dealing with crime is completely UNACCEPTABLE.

I'm sick and tired of hearing about the need for more housing when you officials can't even protect the residents AND tax payers who currently live here! We pay exorbitant property taxes. There is absolutely no excuse why this deluge of crime is happening in our city when it could be resolved by having high penalties and consequences to perpetrators and spending more money on our police force.

My Partner and I are native San Franciscans. We have seen a dramatic change in the brazenness of crimes. A result, we feel, of poor management and the lack of foresight of city officials. We are now being forced to consider going to get trained in owning our own firearms since the city doesn't seem capable of keeping us safe anymore. This is not a negative reflection on the police themselves, but how they and the legal system have been handcuffed by the policies currently in place. We had much higher expectations of a Mayor who is a native. What a disappointment Mayor Breed has been in this arena.

I wouldn't wish what happened to us on anyone but, we implore each one of you to consider how you would feel been woken up in the middle of the night with the headlights of a car that isn't your own smashed into your garage all while your children sleeping in the next room. Shame on all of you for not making crime THE biggest priority during your time in office.
