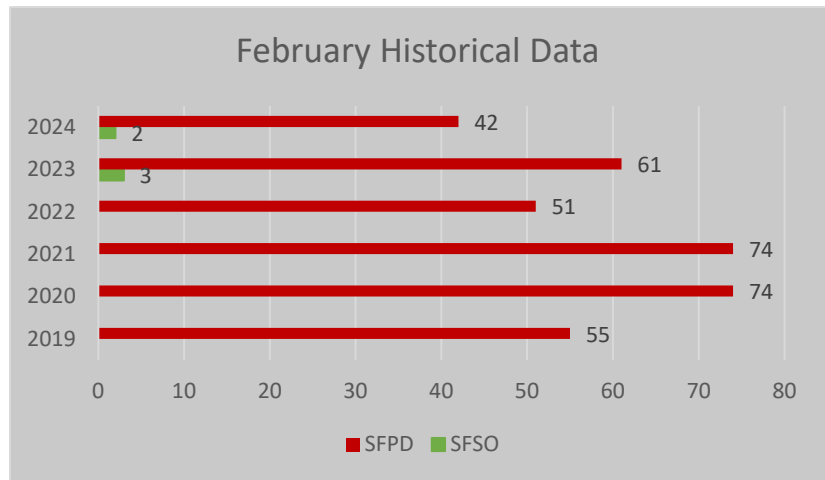

Summary of Complaints Received in February 2024

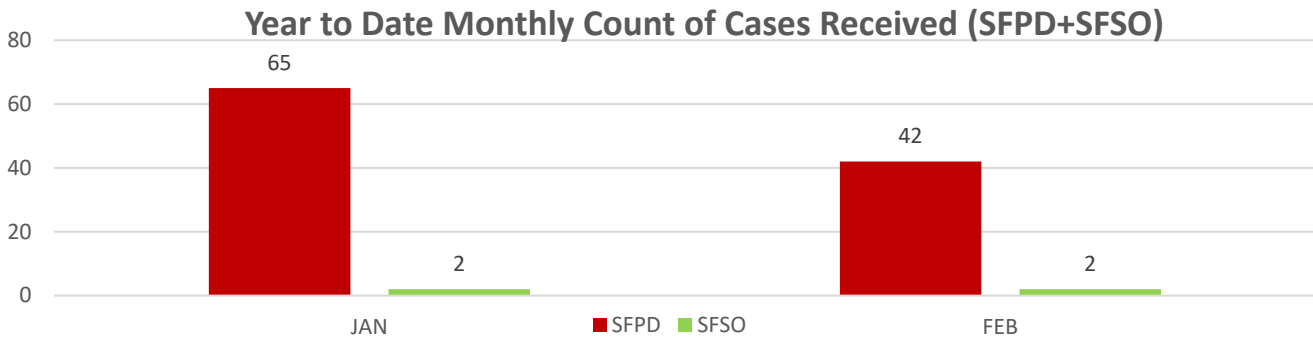
The Department of Police Accountability received a total of **44** cases in **February 2024**, **42** SFPD complaints and **2** SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of **66** cases, **61** SFPD complaints and **5** SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the **February 2024** case total is **30%** lower than the five-year average and the **33%** lower than the previous year.



From January through February, the DPA received a total of **111** new cases, **107** SFPD complaints and **4** SFSO complaints. Compared with the **124** cases filed during the same period in 2022, **116** SFPD complaints and **8** SFSO complaint. The February year to date case total represents an **10%** decrease in new complaints over last year.

Currently, DPA has a total of **340** pending cases, **316** SFPD and **24** SFSO.

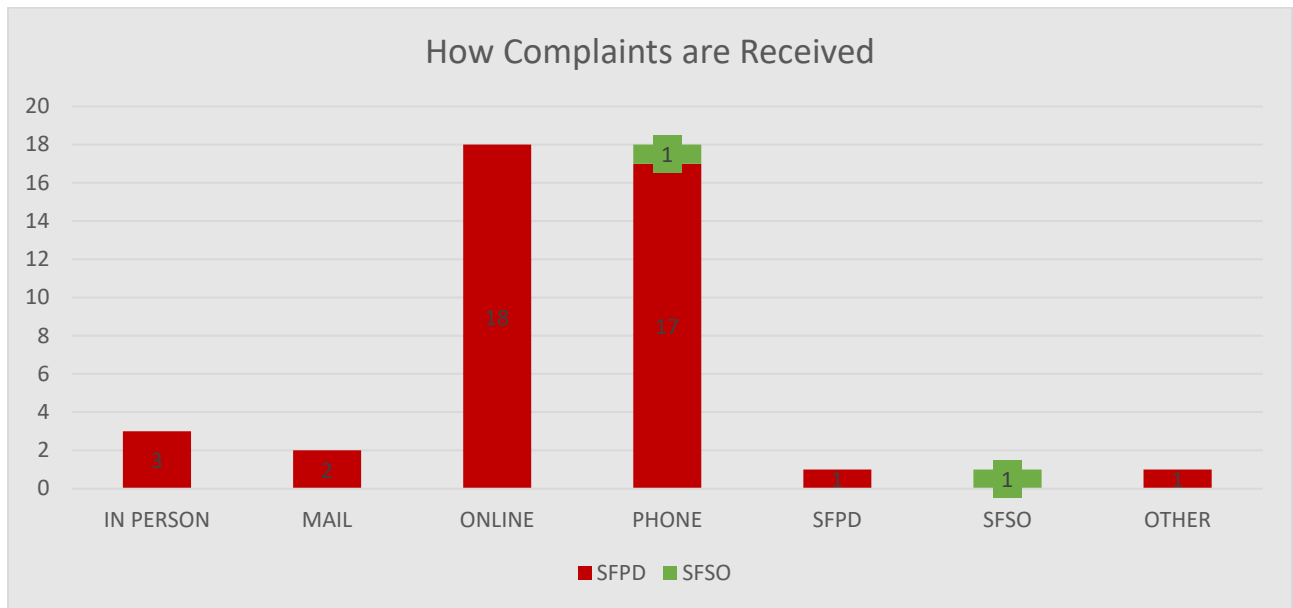
In February, DPA received a total of **1** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and referred a total of **1** case(s) to SFSO.
