
Re: San Francisco Department of Police Accountability March 2024 Monthly Statistical Report

Dear President Cindy Elias and San Francisco Police Commissioners:

Summary of Complaints Received in March 2024

The Department of Police Accountability received a total of **59** cases in **March 2024**, **57** SFPD complaints and **2** SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of **81** cases, **77** SFPD complaints and **4** SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the **March 2024** case total is **13%** lower than the five-year average and the **27%** lower than the previous year.


From January through March, the DPA received a total of 171 new cases,164 SFPD complaints and 7 SFSO complaints. Compared with the 197 cases filed during the same period in 2023, 188 SFPD complaints



and **9** SFSO complaint. The March year to date case total represents a **13**% decrease in new complaints over last year.

Currently, DPA has a total of 301 pending cases, 278 SFPD and 23 SFSO.

In March, DPA <u>received</u> a total of **0** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and <u>referred</u> a total of **2** case(s) to SFSO.


