 and/or identify new training needs.

Rationale for DGO 6.16 Sexual Assaults Working Group

- Engage stakeholders including sexual assault survivors and/or victim advocates to:
 - Continue developing considerations ensuring an unbiased, trauma-informed, and victim-centered approach.
 - Inform the development of new training materials, if needed.
 - Ensure policy allows for victim education regarding the investigative process, victim rights and resources.
- Identify and address common themes of feedback received by DPA on policy implementation.
