I am writing to suggest that the City of SF consider upgrading all SFPD vehicles to be fully bulletproof, akin to the vehicles used by the Secret Service. Given the increasing concerns about officer safety and the rise in violent incidents, such a measure could significantly enhance the protection of our police force.

Bulletproof vehicles have been proven to offer substantial protection against various threats.
