(舊金山) 舊金山選務處已確認罷免三名教育委員的選舉將於明年 2月15 日舉行。罷免教委運動的兩名發起 人拉吉和洛珍與支持者於 11月6日晚間,在米慎區舉行一場競選運動起步酒會,宣布競選運動展開,將在 未來三個月內努力爭取更多選民的支持。

發起人拉吉在酒會上說,「修補地面上的地洞比街道上以什麼命名更為重要。」他比喻在選票上被列名罷免的三名教育委員盧佩思、高勵思及莫力加,任內努力推動將市內44所公校改名,卻忽略了廣大學生面對的種種教育問題。

另一名發起人洛珍則感謝華裔選民及家長在罷免教委運動中的影響力,促使罷免運動成功被列在選票上交由選民表決。

華裔家長林文傑成為這次罷免教委運動的超級義工,他個人收集到近 5000 個支持簽名。他在酒會上說,「他是基於兩大因素決定投入罷免教委的義工行列,第一是看見我的兩個小孩去年在疫情中艱苦地在家裡的電腦前上學,我看見還有許多小孩在學業上退步。許多家長及學生受到影響,但這些教委卻沒有聆聽家長的意見,選擇性地採取其他行動,沒有幫助學生學習。」

林文傑說,「第二因素是教委高勵思的辱華言論,她不應續任舊金山市府及教育公職。」

School board recall activist to challenge Dean Preston for supervisor

An activist who launched the successful movement to recall three San Francisco school board members during the pandemic will run for the Board of Supervisors this November.

Autumn Looijen is expected to file paperwork to run for District 5 supervisor, challenging incumbent Dean Preston, on Monday morning. The district includes the Tenderloin, Hayes Valley, Japantown, Western Addition and Haight Ashbury.

"We see a lot of things that are broken in the city," Looijen said. "I want to take a look at our problems, understand them from all different directions and come up with solutions."

She said San Francisco's current system of government is not working, and she's in the process of talking to community members to better understand the issues, such as the drug addiction crisis in the Tenderloin.

Looijen, 46, a former tech worker and now a full-time political activist with SF Guardians, moved to San Francisco in late 2020 from South Bay and soon pulled paperwork to start the historic school board recall campaign because of her frustrations about the slow pace of reopening schools. San Francisco voters overwhelmingly supported the recall of three school board members in 2022.

Looijen said she and her team had already trained many qualified candidates to run for school board, and she chose to run for supervisor because she needed a bigger platform.


Tuesday's election, is also running for District 5 supervisor.

Preston, a Democratic Socialist and tenants' rights attorney, is the most progressive voice on the Board of Supervisors.

In a statement, Preston's campaign accused both Looijen and Mahmood of receiving money from tech executive Garry Tan, who created controversy due to an angry tweet saying "die slow" to many city supervisors, including Preston.

"Looijen and Mahmood have each taken thousands of dollars from Garry Tan," the statement said. "And neither has repudiated his death threats against seven supervisors."

Tan donated \$25,000 to the campaign for Proposition G to urge the San Francisco public school district to offer algebra for eighth graders, a campaign that was led by Looijen and received overwhelming voter support. Mahmood also received \$5,000 from Tan for his DCCC race.

Another candidate is Allen Jones, a Tenderloin resident and prison reform activist.

I'm the mom who fought to bring algebra back to middle school, and ran the school board recall when our kids were suffering. Both won in a landslide. (Thank you!)

Our schools are now on the mend, but our City is in crisis.

Open drug markets are destroying the Tenderloin, where 3500 kids live... and the problems spread like cancer. Fentanyl is so addictive that people choose it over their own limbs.

We are a sanctuary city: a beacon for gay teens, trans youth, and quirky people who need a place to belong. But when we let drug dealers prey on them, we are no longer a sanctuary.

We have a moral responsibility to stop this suffering and bring our City HOPE.

General Instructions - Candidate Statement

1. Submission Deadline

Candidate statement must be submitted to the Department of Elections no later than 5 p.m., Tuesday, June 11, 2024. If a Candidate does not file a Candidate Statement with the Department of Elections by that time, the candidate's statement will not appear in the Voter Information Pamphlet. On Wednesday, June 12, 2024, the Department of Elections will allow Candidates to review and correct typeset Statements.

Candidates are strongly encouraged to submit an electronic copy with the signed and dated hard copy of their statement (Microsoft Word format preferred). Where a discrepancy exists between the hard copy and electronic copy, the hard copy will be relied upon for all purposes.

The statements filed shall remain confidential until the expiration of the filing deadline. (CAEC §13311)

2. Statements are printed as submitted, no changes or corrections after the filing deadline

Type or print your statement neatly. Proofread your statement carefully before submitting it. Statements will be printed as submitted. You may not make changes or corrections after the deadline for filing. Errors in spelling, punctuation, grammar, or intent will not be corrected by any official agency.

Nothing in this section shall be deemed to make any statement or the authors thereof free from any civil or criminal action or penalty because of any false, slanderous, or libelous statement offered for printing or contained in the Voter Information Pamphlet.

Any candidate who knowingly makes a false statement of a material fact in a Candidate's Statement, with the intent to mislead the voters in connection with their campaign for nomination or election to a nonpartisan office, is punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

General Instructions

4 3. Word Count (CAEC §§9, 13307)

- i. Candidate statement is limited to a maximum of 200 words
- ii. The 200-word count begins after the preprinted introduction: "My qualifications are:"
- iii. "San Francisco" and other proper nouns count as one word. Each name, including middle initial, will count as a word.
- iv. If you include the names of nominators or supporters, the names and any identification will be counted towards the 200-word limit. If you include names of people for whom you have not submitted a Nomination Paper, you must include letters of endorsement from these individuals with original signatures.
- v. The statement of each candidate will be printed in type of uniform size and darkness, and with uniform spacing. Bold, italic, and underlined text will not be used.

4. Restrictions (CAEC §13307, 18351) Your statement shall not include any of the following:

- i. Your party affiliation
- ii. Membership activity in partisan political organizations
- iii. Reference to other candidates for office or to another your qualifications

5. Candidate Statement Review Period

- i. On Wednesday, June 12, 2024, Candidates will be permitted to review and correct typeset statements.
- ii. Beginning noon on Wednesday, June 12, 2024, the public may review submitted candidate statements. This period ends Monday, June 24, 2024 at noon.
