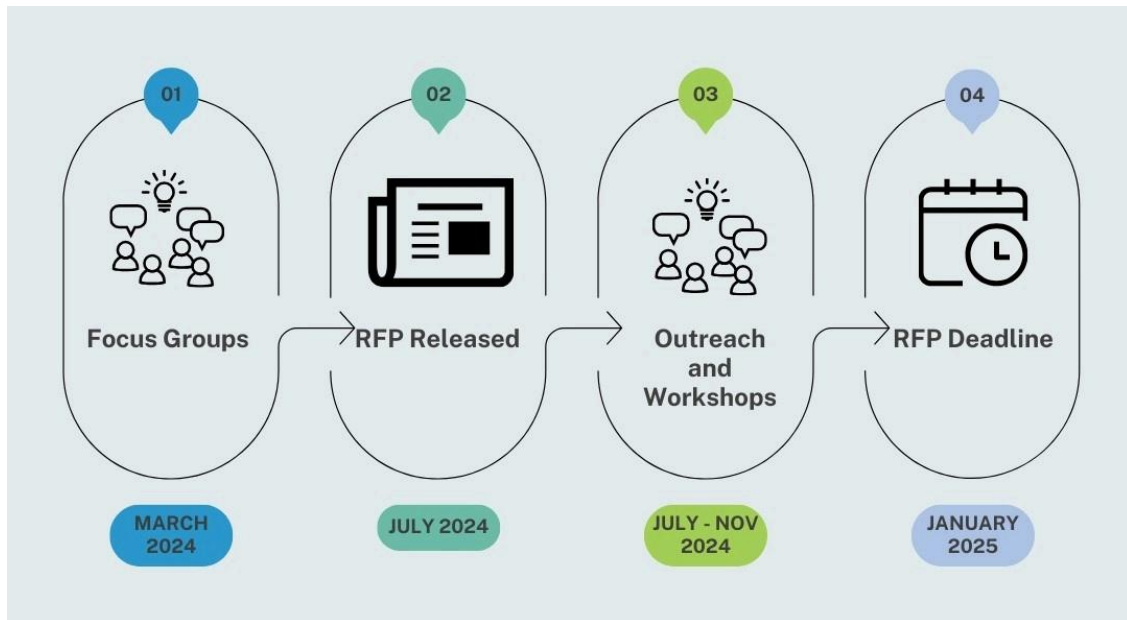


# COMMUNITY CHALLENGE GRANTS

## CCG Grant Cycle Timeline



The [Community Challenge Grants](#) program is an important tool to support community-led, neighborhood improvements. We see community members and City departments engaged in mutual support building neighborhood resilience. We are #bettertogether.

We are collecting community input at focus groups (see below) in March to inform a new Request for Proposals (RFP), which we plan to release in July 2024. The RFP release will be accompanied by a full suite of outreach and technical assistance workshops, July to November 2024.

We anticipate a January 2025 deadline with a grant term starting July 2025.

## Attend a Focus Group

We invite community members to attend one of three focus groups to learn about the program and provide input to make it more responsive to community needs. During this 90-minute meeting, CCG staff will:

- Share the program's background;
- Outline previous requirements;
- Break into small groups to answer questions about community strengths, needs, and experiences applying to a previous RFP.
