Was hoping someone could add that there is a lack of foresight for Safety with the new construction requirement for 82,000 homes to be built per RHNA with the target being Westside. 3500 homes are approved to be built at Stonestown which will impact 19th Avenue. Additionally proposed or in the works:

50 Stories (712 units) by Zoo, 8 stories at Lawton, 7 stories at Lincoln, and 7 stories (90 units) Irving/25th.

We need Great Highway open for ingress/egress in case of fire or flood. San Francisco already is being questioned by Civil Grand Jury on Emergency Preparedness.
