

Summary of Complaints Received in June 2024


The Department of Police Accountability received a total of **61** cases in **June 2024**, **59** SFPD complaints and **2** SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of **69** cases, **63** SFPD complaints and **6** SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the **June 2024** case total is **12%** lower than the five-year average and the **12%** lower than the previous year.

From January through June, the DPA received a total of **387** new cases, **368** SFPD complaints and **19** SFSO complaints. Compared with the **399** cases filed during the same period in 2023, **378** SFPD complaints and **21** SFSO complaint. The June year to date case total represents a **3%** decrease in new complaints over last year.



Currently, DPA has a total of 230 pending cases, 208 SFPD and 22 SFSO.

In June, DPA <u>received</u> a total of **0** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and <u>referred</u> a total of **1** case(s) to SFSO.


