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For your reference, the relevant provisions of Elections Code section 13107 are reproduced below:

- (a) With the exception of candidates for Justice of the State Supreme Court or court of appeal, immediately under the name of each candidate, and not separated from the name by any line, unless the designation made by the candidate pursuant to Section 8002.5 must be listed immediately below the name of the candidate pursuant to Section 13105, and in that case immediately under the designation, may appear at the option of the candidate only one of the following designations:
- (1) Words designating the elective city, county, district, state, or federal office which the candidate holds at the time of filing the nomination documents to which the candidate was elected by vote of the people.
- (2) The word "incumbent" if the candidate is a candidate for the same office which the candidate holds at the time of filing the nomination papers, and was elected to that office by a vote of the people. A candidate shall not use the word "incumbent" if the candidate was elected to their office in an at-large election and is a candidate in a district-based election.
- (3) No more than three words designating either the current principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate, or the principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate during the calendar year immediately preceding the filing of nomination documents.
- (4) The phrase "appointed incumbent" if the candidate holds an office by virtue of appointment, and the candidate is a candidate for election to the same office, or, if the candidate is a candidate for election to the same office or to some other office, the word "appointed" and the title of the office. In either instance, the candidate may not use the unmodified word "incumbent" or any words designating the office unmodified by the word "appointed." However, the phrase "appointed incumbent" shall not be required of a candidate who seeks reelection to an office which the candidate holds and to which the candidate was appointed, as a nominated candidate, in lieu of an election, pursuant to Sections 5326 and 5328 of the Education Code or Section 7228, 7423, 7673, 10229, or 10515 of this code.
- (b) (1) Except as specified in paragraph (2), for candidates for judicial office, immediately under the name of each candidate, and not separated from the name by any line, only one of the following designations may appear at the option of the candidate:
- (A) Words designating the city, county, district, state, or federal office held by the candidate at the time of filling the nomination documents.
- (B) The word "incumbent" if the candidate is a candidate for the same office that the candidate holds at the time of filing the nomination papers.
- (C) No more than three words designating either the current principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate, or the principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate during the calendar year immediately preceding the filing of nomination documents.
- (2) For a candidate for judicial office who is an active member of the State Bar employed by a city, county, district, state, or by the United States, the designation shall appear as one of the following:
- (A) Words designating the actual job title, as defined by statute, charter, or other governing instrument.
- (B) One of the following ballot designations: "Attorney," "Attorney at Law," "Lawyer," or "Counselor at Law." The designations "Attorney" and "Lawyer" may be used in combination with one other current principal profession, vocation, or occupation of the candidate during the calendar year immediately preceding the filing of nomination documents.
- (3) A designation made pursuant to subparagraph (A) of paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) shall also contain relevant qualifiers, as follows:
- (A) If the candidate is an official or employee of a city, the name of the city shall appear preceded by the words "City of."
- (B) If the candidate is an official or employee of a county, the name of the county shall appear preceded by the words "County of."
- (C) If the candidate is an official or employee of a city and county, the name of the city and county shall appear preceded by the words "City and County."
- (D) If the candidate performs quasi-judicial functions for a governmental agency, the full name of the agency shall be included.
- (c) A candidate for superior court judge who is an active member of the State Bar and practices law as one of the candidate's principal professions shall use one of the following ballot designations as the candidate's ballot designation: "Attorney," "Attorney at Law," "Lawyer," or "Counselor at Law." The designations "Attorney" and "Lawyer" may be used in combination with one other current principal profession, vocation, or occupation of the candidate, or the principal profession, vocation, or occupation of the candidate during the calendar year immediately preceding the filing of nomination documents.
- (d) For purposes of this section, all California geographical names shall be considered to be one word. Hyphenated words that appear in any generally available standard reference dictionary, published in the United States at any time within the 10 calendar years immediately preceding the election for which the words are counted, including a generally available standard reference dictionary published online, shall be considered as one word. Each part of all other hyphenated words shall be counted as a separate word.
- (e) The Secretary of State and any other elections official shall not accept a designation of which any of the following would be true:

LGBTQ Organizations Condemn Efforts to Divide Queer and Trans Communities, and Call to Keep Tenderloin and Western SOMA United in District 6

同志組織聯盟共同譴責三藩市重劃選區工作組試圖重劃選區界線打散同志社區力量

[San Francisco] On Wednesday, a coalition of LGBTQ organizations jointly condemned efforts by the San Francisco Redistricting Task Force to redraw district lines in San Francisco in ways that would sever longstanding transgender and queer communities, neighborhood ties, and cultural districts.

At a press conference, leaders from the Transgender District, the Leather and LGBTQ Cultural District, the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club, the Alice B Toklas LGBTQ Democratic Club, and the Tenderloin People's Congress called for the Tenderloin neighborhood and western. SoMa, two neighborhoods with deep connections and home to two of the City's LGBTQ cultural districts, to be kept together and in District 6.

"It is imperative that we keep SOMA and Tenderloin together as well as keeping Transgender District in District 6 along with Soma Pilipinas and the LEATHER & LGBTQ Cultural District. Despite mobilizing dozens of community members to speak at the Task Force hearings, the current proposals do not maintain the current Cultural District boundaries within the same District. We are united in making this collaborative effort to ensure that communities of interest have their voices heard," said Bob Brown, Board President of the Leather and LGBTQ Cultural District.

San Francisco's Supervisorial district lines are in the midst of being redrawn in a once-a-decade process to rebalance district populations following the Census. New maps are drawn by the San Francisco Redistricting Task Force, a nine member body appointed by the Mayor, Department of Elections, and Board of Supervisors, with sole and final authority to determine the new lines. Under law, new lines must be decided and approved by April 15th.

The Task Force is required to take into account recognized neighborhoods and "communities of interest", designations that include Cultural Districts and the queer and trans communities.

"LGBTQ people are not accurately or adequately counted in the Census. The Redistricting Task Force has to do more to listen and engage with queer and trans people to keep our communities intact. We refuse to be divided, diminished, or disempowered, and the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club stands united with every other LGBTQ organization calling for this. Harvey Milk was only able to become the first LGBTQ person elected to public office in

California because of District elections. These lines matter, and we will not be silent or go backwards," said Edward Wright, President of the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club

"The Alice B. Toklas LGBTQ Democratic Club is thankful for the efforts the Redistricting Task Force has done, and continues to do, in balancing various community needs and voices throughout San Francisco. However, our struggles in the LGBTQ community are far from overin fact, we've seen attacks on our community increase nationwide over the last several years. Locally, our representation on the San Francisco Board of Supervisors is at a historic low, with only one openly gay member. We stand united with the Tenderloin and SoMa LGBTQ communities in ensuring our voices and power are not diluted between two separate districts," stated Gary McCoy, Senior Co-Chair, Alice B. Toklas LGBTQ Democratic Club.

【三藩市】週三,在新聞發布會上,三藩市市立跨性別區、市立皮革與同志文化區、Harvey Milk 同志民主黨支部、Alice B Toklas 同志民主黨支部以及田德隆人民代表大會的領袖同聲一致呼籲,田德隆社區和Market街以南(SOMA)一帶,兩個擁有深厚聯繫並且是兩個市內同志文化區的所在地,應該保持在一起並劃歸第六選區。

皮革與同志文化區董事會主席Bob Brown更強調: "保持SoMa和田德隆在一起以及將跨性別區保留在第六選區與菲律賓裔Soma Pilipinas和皮革與同志文化區放在同一選區是至關重要的。儘管動員了數十名社區成員在聽證會上發言,但目前的提案並沒有理會我們訴求。我們共同努力倡議、確保社區力量的聲音被忽略。"

三藩市市參事選區界線正在被重劃,這是每十年一次的過程。新地圖由三藩市重劃選區工作組繪製,該工作組由市長、選舉部門和市參事任命的九名成員組成,擁有決定新界線的唯一和最終權力。根據法律,新界線必須在4月15日前決定和批准。工作組必須考慮已認可的社區和"利益社區",1包括文化區和同志及跨性別社區。

Harvey Milk 同志民主黨支部主席王愛德(Edward Wright)更再三指出:"同志社區在人口普查中沒有得到準確或充分的卻準統計。重劃選區工作組必須聆聽同志及跨性別人群互動,以保持我們社區完整。我們拒絕被分裂、削弱或剝奪權力! Harvey Milk 同志民主黨支部與其他所有同志組織站在同一陣線呼籲這一點。Harvey Milk能成為加州首位當選公職的同志人士是因為區域選舉集中我們社區力量。"


Alice B. Toklas 同志民主黨支部主席麥佳禮(Gary McCoy)更表示"Alice B. Toklas 同志民主黨支部感謝重劃選區工作組在平衡三藩市各個社區需求和聲音方面所做和繼續做的努力。然而,我們在同志社區的鬥爭遠未結束——事實上,本地,我們在三藩市的市參事數目處於歷史低點,只有一名公開的同志市參事。我們需要確保我們的聲音和力量不會在兩個不同的選區間被分散。"

I've been using the Chinese translation of my name, 王愛德, in public life and public service for six years. As Campaign Mananger (2018) and then Legislative Aide (2019-2023) for District 4 Supervisor Gordon Mar, it was on my business cards in representing our campaign and office to the public and to Chinese media, on behalf of a district that is majority AAPI and home to thousands of Chinese speakers. As President and chief spokesperson for the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club (2021-2022), I used it in press releases shared with Chinese language media. I've continued to use 王愛德 as my Chinese name in my role as a Transit Strategic Communications Advisor (2024) for the SFMTA and City and County of San Francisco.

I've included evidence of my public use of this name for the past six years below, in the form of business cards and a press release. I believe this name was how I was referred to in Chinese language media during my time in Supervisor Mar's office, where I was our primary liaison to Chinese language media, and while leading the Milk Club. Sing Tao and World Journal, the primary Chinese language media outlets in San Francisco, do not archive their past stories, and given that I did not plan to run for office years in advance, and the current Chinese name verification requirements for candidates were only very recently adopted, I did not proactively save evidence of those stories.



Instructions – Schedule D Income – Gifts

A gift is anything of value for which you have not provided equal or greater consideration to the donor. A gift is reportable if its fair market value is \$50 or more. In addition, multiple gifts totaling \$50 or more received during the reporting period from a single source must be reported.

It is the acceptance of a gift, not the ultimate use to which it is put, that imposes your reporting obligation. Except as noted below, you must report a gift even if you never used it or if you gave it away to another person.

- An honorarium received prior to assuming office (You may report an honorarium as income on Schedule C, rather than as a gift on Schedule D, if you provided services of equal or greater value than the payment received. See Reference Pamphlet, page 10.)
- Transportation and lodging (See Schedule E.)

Reminders

- Gifts from a single source are subject to a \$590 limit in 2023. (See Reference Pamphlet, page 10.)

- Personalized plaques or trophies with an individual value of less than \$250
- Campaign contributions
- Up to two tickets, for your own use, to attend a fundraiser for a campaign committee or candidate, or to a fundraiser for an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The ticket must be received from the organization or committee holding the fundraiser.
- Gifts given to members of your immediate family if the source has an established relationship with the family member and there is no evidence to suggest the donor had a purpose to influence you. (See Regulation 18943.)
- Free admission, food, and nominal items (such as a pen, pencil, mouse pad, note pad or similar item) available to all attendees, at the event at which the official makes a speech (as defined in Regulation 18950(b)(2)), so long as the admission is provided by the person who organizes the event.
- Any other payment not identified above, that would otherwise meet the definition of gift, where the payment is made by an individual who is not a lobbyist registered to lobby the official's state agency, where it is clear that the gift was made because of an existing personal or business relationship unrelated to the official's position and there is no evidence whatsoever at the time the gift is made to suggest the donor had a purpose to influence you.


