DID FUNDING ADD NEW SERVICES/ OR EXPAND SERVICES

New services added

1. We were able to hire a Project coordinator from the community.
 - TAYE youth-Black-Female- and had been volunteering when possible with the CARE program.
2. Able to hire outreach workers – from community
 - TAYE youth from community
3. Provide stipends for Community Youth Leaders

Improve existing services

1. Continue with gardening program and pay a stipend to the youth
 - Involved OFA youth so they could learn about the tools and gardening
2. Garden supplies and installing smaller gardens for the seniors in front of their units.
 - Youth working with the seniors telling stories of their experiences and learning from each other

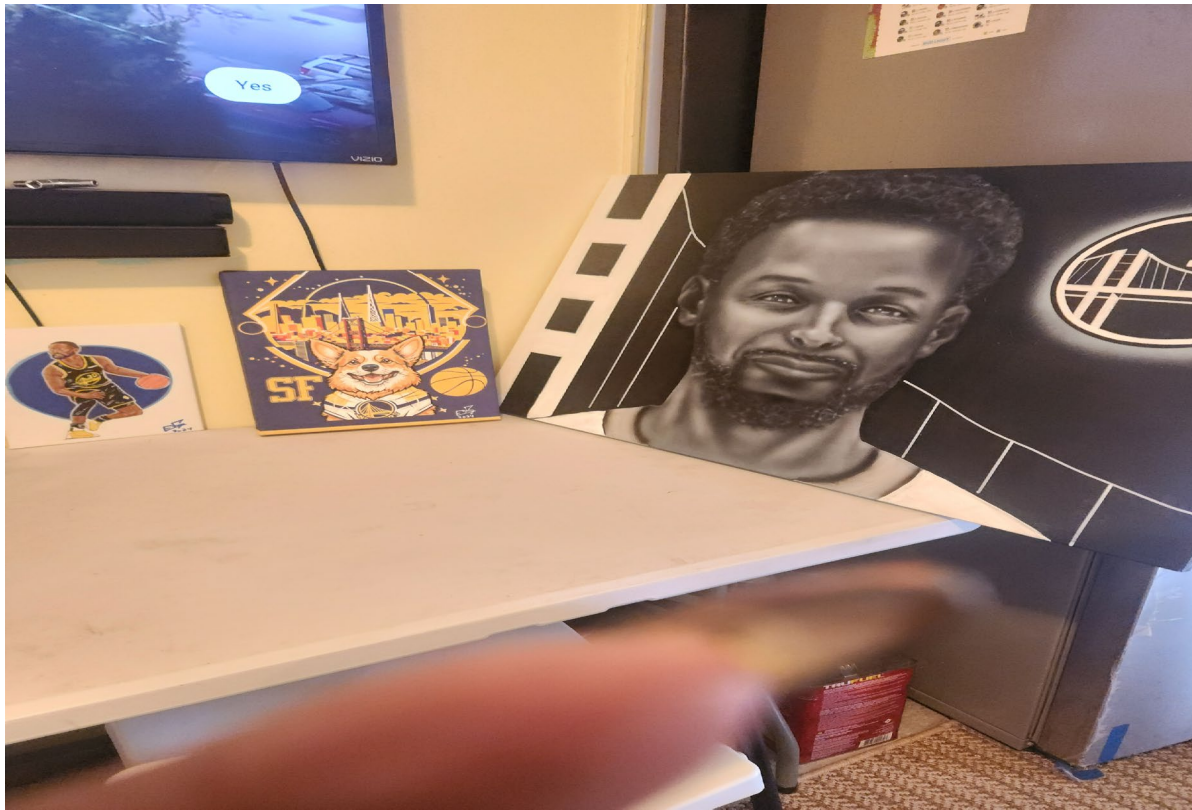

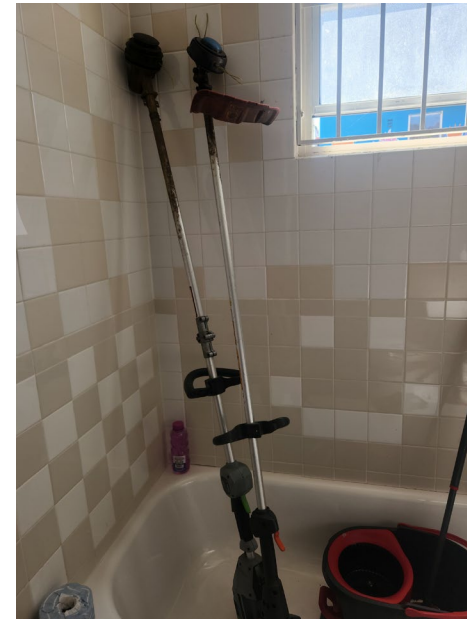


EMPOWERING OUR YOUTH
