Subject: Request for Funds for Community Engagement and Officers Wellness.

Southern Station is respectfully requesting \$25,000.00 from Community Engagement Division for upcoming Community Engagement and officer wellness events.

This would include Southern Station's annual Halloween Pumpkin and Candy Giveaway. This event, held at the Public Safety Building, draws approximately 200 children and their families each year. The funds would be used to buy supplies for a Haunted House, candy and pumpkins to give away to the children.

The second event would be our Annual Turkey Trot 5k held on Thanksgiving Morning. This event continues to grow each year and is open to all Department members. Southern Station asks for a donation from each participant and the money raised is used to buy snacks and supplies which are donated to Family House. Family House, located at 540 Mission Bay Blvd. North, helps house children and the families free of charge while they are receiving treatment at UCSF. The funds provided would help purchase t-shirts for each of the Turkey Trot participants.

This money would also be used to help enhance officer wellness and fund Southern Station's annual Christmas Party. This would help us secure a venue, purchase food and pay a DJ.

The funds provided would be held in the Southern Station Floral fund. After all events the left-over funds will be returned along with receipts from each of the events.

*The San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance (San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 67) as approved by the San Francisco voters in 1999, provides that SEC. 67.29-.6 Sources of Outside Funding. No official or employee or agent of the city shall accept, allow to be collected, or direct or influence the spending of, any money, or any goods or services worth more than one hundred dollars in aggregate, for the purpose of carrying out or assisting any City function unless the amount and source of all such funds is disclosed as a public record and made available on the website for the department to which the funds are directed. When such funds are provided or managed by an entity, and not an individual, that entity must agree in writing to abide by this ordinance. The disclosure shall include the names of all individuals or organizations contributing such money and a statement as to any financial interest the contributor has involving the City.
