2	BUSINESSES]

4	Resolution acknowledging the significant impact of immigrant-owned small businesses
5	by adding to the fabric of San Francisco, strengthening its local economy, and
6	enhancing the uniqueness of our city. It also calls on the City and County of San
7	Francisco to prioritize strategies to support and preserve our iconic small business
8	corridors that are part of our rich culture.
9	
10	WHEREAS, Small businesses have substantially contributed to the unique character of
11	San Francisco by enriching its corridors from Chinatown, Tenderloin, Mission, Clement, and
12	Bayview to many other iconic corners of the city, accounting for approximately 95% of all
13	businesses in San Francisco; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, Immigrant-owned small businesses play an outstanding role in creating
16	jobs, boosting our local economy, and promoting diverse cultures in our business corridors;
17	and;
18	
19	WHEREAS, Small businesses strengthen and revitalize San Francisco's local economy
20	and more than one-third are immigrant owned. These businesses include hairstylists,
21	restaurants, flower shops, and many others that accentuate the uniqueness of cultural district
22	corridors; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, The pandemic forced many small businesses to close due to the
25	unforeseen economic and systemic challenges; and

2	WHEREAS, The Immigrant Rights Commission emphasizes the importance of
3	immigrant-owned small businesses and their achievements and contributions to making San
4	Francisco more vibrant and diverse; now, therefore, be it
5	
6	RESOLVED, That the Immigrant Rights Commission commits to promoting immigrant-
7	owned small businesses in different neighborhoods during this holiday season; and be it
8	
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Immigrant Rights Commission urges the City and
10	County of San Francisco to address language access needs, increase support for businesses
11	facing displacement, and expand culturally competent small business outreach in order to
12	support monolingual small business owners; and be it
13	
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Immigrant Rights Commission shall transmit a copy
15	of this to the Mayor, Board of Supervisors, and Office of Small Business.
