## **BUSINESS DESCRIPTION**

Image Conscious is a publisher and distributor of fine art posters. They are one of the largest wholesale poster suppliers worldwide, selling to galleries, frame shops, designers, art dealers, poster shops and online retailers. The business is located on 10th Street between Howard Street and Mission Street. The business was officially established by 1983 by George Leeson, who began publishing art in the basement of his apartment in 1980.

# CRITERION 1: Has the applicant has operated in SF for 30 or more years, with no break in SF operations exceeding two years?

Yes, the applicant has operated in San Francisco for 30 or more years, with no break in San Francisco operations exceeding two years:

45 Sheridan Street from 1983-1989 (6 years) 147-149 Tenth Street from 1989-Present (27 years)

I would like to formally nominate Image Conscious, a publisher and distributer of fine art posters. It is one of largest wholesale poster suppliers worldwide, selling to to galleries, frame shops, designers, art dealers, poster shops, and online retailers.

It has been owned by George Leeson, who began publishing in the basement of his apartment in 1980. The business more officially began its operations in 1983, when it bought out another publisher and opened its doors at 45 Sheridan. In 1989, the company moved to 147-149 Tenth Street. It has operated continuously for 33 years. While beginning with one employee, it grew to 15 employees by 1988, and in 2004, employed 30 people. The company was hit by set-backs in the financial crisis of 2008 and the bankruptcy of one of its suppliers. The company was forced to re-group and today has sales of \$2 million and employs fifteen people.

Image Conscious is a vendor to many local arts organizations including Back to the Picture, Fastframe, The Artisans, and Image Arts. It also pays royalties to local artists who supply the company with art and photography. The Legacy Business designation would help Image Conscious continue to serve the arts community of the South of Market, the Bay Area, and worldwide on the web.

## IMAGE CONSCIOUS BUSINESS NARRATIVE

Image Conscious publishes and distributes fine art posters and open edition giclees. It is solely owned by George Leeson, who began the business in the basement of his apartment in 1980. The business more effectively began operations in 1983, when it bought out another publisher, Drucker-Vincent, then located at 45 Sheridan Street in San Francisco, and rented space at that location. In 1989, the company moved to its current headquarters at 147-149 Tenth Street. It has operated continuously for 33 years.

The business was an outgrowth of Leeson's experience working as an employee at Union Street Graphics, at 1690 Union Street, San Francisco, beginning in 1974. Leeson was employed there until 1983, when he bought out Drucker-Vincent, and moved his business to 45 Sheridan.

The business began in 1983 with one employee, but grew rapidly. By 1988, Image Conscious exceeded two million dollars in sales, and had some 15 employees. At its peak, in 2004, Image Conscious had annual revenues of six million, and employed some 30 people. In the period from 2008 to 2010, the company experienced two major setbacks: The financial crisis of 2008, and the bankruptcy of a major European supplier in 2010. The company was forced to re-group, cutting staff sharply, and re-focusing on its own publishing efforts. Today the company has sales of about two million dollars, and employs fifteen.

The company's main contribution to the community has been to provide long-terms jobs to its employees. While a few of its employees reside in the East Bay, most of its employees live or have lived in San Francisco. Of the current roster of fifteen employees, four began their employment in the 1980s; another three in the 1990s; several more before 2010.

Image Conscious is a vendor to any number of local companies, including Back to the Picture, Fastframe, The Artisans and Image Arts. It also pays royalties to many Bay Area artists who supply the company with art and photography.

I firmly believe Image Conscious meets both the letter and the spirit of a Legacy Business.


