Is the performance bond just for one year or for multiple years? | The bid bond and performance bond requirements apply to the proposal and first service year respectively. If the contract is renewed, the performance bond may be waived dependent on approval by the City and CDE/CDSS. |
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| 12/3/2024 | Do we need proof of being a city supplier if we are already one? | Currently suppliers need only provide their SF Supplier ID in Attachment 1 (Proposer Coversheet and References). |
| 12/3/2024 | Do we still need #8 OVS form CPU 18d even though you don't use Offer vs. Serve? | CDSS requires the OVS form (CPU18d) even if we do not participate in Offer vs. Service. The form has a section for providers not using Offer vs. Serve to complete |
