- 3. Robert Feinbaum, President of SaveMUNI, expressed concerns about cutting Muni service and shared that the SFMTA could work with federal and state partners to allow shifting of capital funds for operations.
- 4. Joshua expressed that improving Muni ridership also saves lives and cautioned against spreading misinformation.
