

Obtaining Transcripts from City College of San Francisco

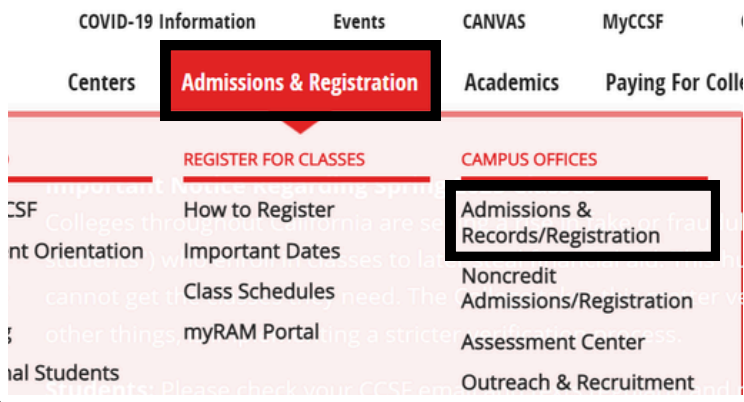
A Minimum Qualification (MQ) of the 7327 Apprentice Maintenance Machinist I position requires proof of one (1) year of High School Algebra or one (1) term of college Algebra with a passing cumulative grade of "C-" or better.

Your official transcripts MUST state "Algebra", or the like. If your algebra course was entitled "Integrated Math", "Math 90" or the like, your school must include a letter written on letterhead that states the course you took was the equivalent to algebra.

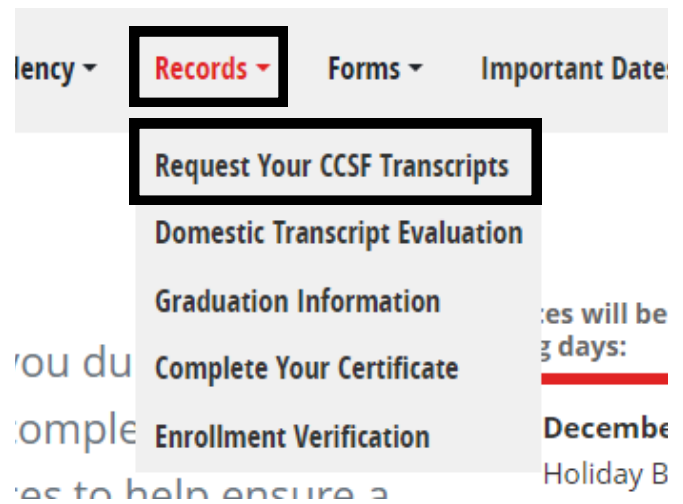
Step 1: Navigate to the City College of San Francisco's website.

Step 2:

Select "Admissions & Registrations," then under "Campus Offices," select "Admissions & Records/Registration."



Step 3: Under "Records," select "Request Your CCSF Transcripts."



Step 4: Order your Official or Unofficial Transcripts from CCSF.

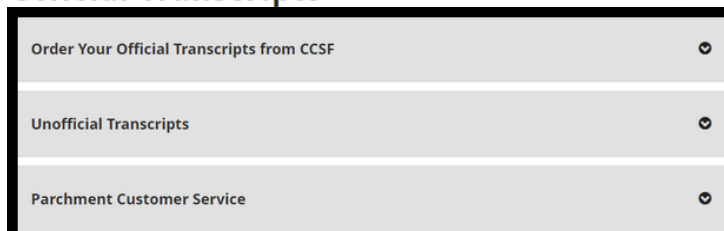
